Our Tile Installer Apprenticeship Program is the main program of our institution. We equip you with all the essential skills and tools that will allow you to be successful as you begin your new path as a Tile Installer. After completing the apprenticeship, you will be able to demonstrate consistent skills and knowledge associated with all currently used thin-set installation techniques being used in the American Market. Not only do we train you, but we can also help connect you with available jobs before and during the Apprenticeship.

This program is designed for students who have already completed the Tile Finisher Program.



### **What does a Tile Finisher do?**

Mix thin-set and grout • Specialty cuts • Centering • Leveling • Sloping  
• Screeding • Slippage management • Curb installing • Work with complex layouts • Waterproofing • Other Worksite/Tool Maintenance and Housekeeping • Communicating with veteran tile installers



### **What does the program look like?**

This is a 2 ½-3 year program running on a rotation of 2 ½(10 weeks) months in classroom/workshop learning followed by 4-5 months of On-The-Job Training.



### **What happens after I finish the program?**

Upon completion of all requirements, Apprentices are awarded a Recognized Certificate for Tile Installer by the Department of Labor. Many of our partnering companies have needs for skilled trade workers. There is a large shortage of construction workers in general and a particularly large need for trade workers with tile installation skills.



### **How much does this cost?**

Financial assistance is available to cover anywhere from 50% - 100% of the cost of the program. Please contact the Academy to find out what you may qualify for!
